Introduction

The 3rd International Fire Safety of Facade (FSF 2019) is held in Paris, France from September 25 to 27 st, 2019. Organised by CSTB (Centre Scientifique et Technique du Bâtiment), the French Building Research Institute, FSF is a three-day event that fosters dialogue among scientists, academics and professionals from around the world related to the research and development in the field of facade fire safety. FSF 2019 will promote the cooperation between manufacturers and researchers.

In the attempt to contribute to risk mitigation to reduce consequences on human life and property, the objectives of the international symposium are the following:

- to present the latest state of the art in the knowledge of fire safety for facade,
- to gather experts of this domain to discuss research questions and practical application,
- to emphasize the importance of further development of research.

Symposium scope & topics

FSF 2019 encourages participation of engineers, researchers, industrialists and regulation experts working in the field of facade fire safety.

Participants interested in presenting scientific work are invited submit abstracts related to the following topics:

1. Facade materials and systems behaviour in fire
2. Fire testing and assessments methods
3. Numerical modelling and FSE of facade fires
4. Practical applications and case studies of facade fires
5. Regulation and standardization
